Czech Presidential Elections 2013 - for the first time in history, the President of the Czech Republic will be chosen directly by Czech citizens in the January 2013 elections. The first round of the elections will be held on January 11-12, with a potential run-off on January 25-26. Czech citizens (regardless of their immigration status in the US) will be able to vote in the United States, on the premises of the Embassy in Washington and Consulates General in New York, Los Angeles and Chicago.
