Thanks to your support we can afford to have more Czech and Slovak teachers, purchase more Czech and Slovak books and other school material which our teachers can then use to teach the children in our community our native languages, appreciation of our culture, and love for our Czech and Slovak heritage.

Many of you know that American Sokol celebrated 150 years of its existence last year (2015). Many of you know who Miroslav Tyrs was. PARENTS:
