About the St. Nicholas Treasure Hunt

This is fully an outdoor event where families sign up and arrive during designated time slots to participate in a treasure hunt and meet St. Nicholas, an Angel and a Devil. Each child will receive a special gift from St. Nicholas, in a socially distanced manner.

Sign-ups are available in 15-minute time slots between 10 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. There will be staggered start times and visits with St. Nicholas.

Families are then welcome to hike on their own around the lake or anywhere else in the park.

Please note that this is a non-traditional way to see the traditional trio of St. Nicholas, an Angel and a Devil. Due to health and safety precautions, this event comes with several requirements including mandatory pre-registration and COVID-19 safety protocols.



Participants are expected to:

- · Register your family in advance. Walk-ins will not be allowed.
- · Arrive at the Registration Desk during your family's timeslot.
- Registration fee will be returned if you cancel in advance through EventBrite.
- As per Fairfax County Park Authority rules: Visitors ages two and older must wear a mask when social distancing cannot be maintained.
- At Registration Desk: All participants must wear a proper face mask and declare that they do not have COVID symptoms. Temperature will be taken of each participant. (Body temperature must be below 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit).
 - Bring your own drinks and food.
- Select a short course (~1 km) or a longer course (~2 km). These two courses are planned to better improve social distancing.
- When waiting to meet or meeting with St. Nicholas, the Angel, and the Devil: Keep a mask on and maintain social distance. When finished, leave the area as quickly as possible do not linger.
- Restrooms and Sanitation: Restroom facilities will be available. Hand sanitizer will be available for participants' use at the registration desk and at St. Nicholas station.

You then choose to complete your distance as you see fit. Every day, every other day, 5 days a week. At the end of 30 days, you should reach your exercise goal that challenges you. Plus, you'll have the rest of us in the group to encourage you




