Scholarship Opportunity for College Students:

American Sokol Washington, D.C., a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, has established a <u>scholarship</u> <u>fund</u> in support of deserving students who assist in the activities of our organization, as an additional service to the community.

THE SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- The Scholarship is available to applicants who are college-bound seniors or college freshmen, sophomores or juniors.
- The applicant must have a history of volunteering in Sokol Washington programs and events.
- The applicant's parents or the applicant (if over 18) must be a Sokol Washington member in good standing.
- The applicant must have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or better.
- The applicant must have demonstrated leadership and sportsmanship attributes through participation in a range of community and scholastic activities.
- If awarded, the Scholarship funds will be paid in the name of the recipient directly to the college of enrollment.
- A student who receives a full scholarship from another source is not eligible for the Scholarship.


