## Ski camp at Hunter Mountain



For the week between **December 26**, **2021**, **and January 2**, **2022**, Sokol will organize a ski camp at Hunter Mountain. Hunter says it is "the closest big mountain close to NYC," making it the closest big mountain close to DC., some 340 miles and 5.5 hours from Washington, DC. Hunter's top is at 3,200 feet, similar to Burke's 3,300 feet; 100% of their trails have snowmaking and intriguing north-facing trails that promise challenging skiing.

If you are interested, contact us as soon as possible, with the subject line "Winter ski camp". The camp will take place only if a sufficient number of families confirm participation.

In the email, please include the name of each person; and the child's age.

A deposit (\$500-1,000 per family) is required by the end of October at the latest.

To guarantee safety, Sokol will require all participants older than 12 years to be fully vaccinated before the camp and provide proof of vaccination by December 1, 2021. Once at Hunter, we will follow and implement all valid anti-pandemic recommendations.
