
SOKOL ADVENT CHALLENGE

Children can't wait for the Mikulašská nádilka – St. Nicholas Feast – a beloved tradition and the most popular event of our Unit. The arrival of Mikuláš (St. Nicholas), along with the angel and the devil, carrying traditional stocking gifts, always delights the children, as well as the adults. He even found his way to visit our children during Covid. We kept it outdoors in the park and at the Czech Embassy, as indoor activities were impossible.

The first Sokol Washington Mikulašská was in 1956 to benefit the Czechoslovak School's children and their friends. We continue the tradition. A fleet of volunteers bakes and provides large quantities of koláčky, vánočky, Christmas cookies, perníčky, and other delicious traditional sweets. We always order a surplus of sausages (jaternice, jelita/krvavničky, klobásy) and offer them for sale at the end of the dinner.




Czech Christmas Market Children's Performance



After a terrible accident destroyed her childhood, Šarlota (Natalia Germani) returns to her regressive mountain hometown for the first time in 20 years. She finds her mother's house burned to the ground, so she takes refuge in a supposedly haunted cabin abandoned on the edge of town by a witch. As old and new wounds reopen, she connects with Mira (Eva Mores), a rebellious young woman with secrets of her own. Slovak director Michal Blaško's first powerful feature motion picture, Victim, is a tense social thriller set in a small Czech border town. Ukrainian immigrant Irina (Vita Smachelyuk) is preparing her application for European citizenship while working as a housekeeper and caring for her 13-year-old son Igor (Gleb Kuchuk), a promising young gymnast.

Igor is the Victim of an attack that lands him in hospital. He indirectly identifies the assailants as three local Roma boys. The community is swift to rally around the young man. Still, as latent anti-Roma sentiment bubbles to the surface and Igor's case becomes coopted by right-wing campaigners and others stoking racist and xenophobic flames, Irina notices some inconsistencies in her son's story. Faced with an impossible moral dilemma and feeling manipulated from all sides, Irina must navigate a highwire act between justice and her impulse to protect her son and the life she built.

Are You Interested in voting in January 2023 Czech Presidential Election?

IMPORTANT: December 4, 2022, is the deadline for registration of Czech voters living abroad. You must register at the Czech Embassy or your corresponding Czech consular office.



The first round of voting in the USA is scheduled for Thursday, January 12, and Friday, January 13, 2023.

The election date in the Czech Republic is scheduled for 13 and 14 January 2023, with the possible second round

Friday, January 27, 2023.

Because of the time difference, the first round of voting in the USA is scheduled for Thursday, January 12, and Friday, January 13, 2023. A possible second round of the presidential elections would be held on Thursday, January 26, and Friday, January 27, 2023.

Polling stations will be located within the premises of four Czech diplomatic and consular missions.

Polling stations will be open to Czech citizens eligible to vote from 2 pm until 9 pm in local times on the above-mentioned days.

Kapustnica is a festive Slovak Christmas soup. This soup is usually made around wintertime and Christmas but is excellent for any day if you ask me. It is made with sauerkraut, sausage, mushrooms, and flavorful spices like caraway seeds, paprika, and marjoram. Spices will vary with each family.

Directions

Rinse the sauerkraut in water, so it is not too acidic. (I save some of the juice just in case I rinsed it too much and need to add acid).

Place the sauerkraut, broth, peppercorns, bay leaves, marjoram, salt, and mushrooms into a large pot, and bring to a boil. Add the sausage. Let it simmer over medium heat for 1 1/2 hours.

Remove the sausage from the soup, and set aside. Remove bay leaves, and discard.

Heat the oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add the onion, and fry until transparent. Sprinkle the flour and paprika over the onion; cook and stir for a minute. Gradually stir in the water with a fork so that no lumps form. Bring to a boil, and allow to thicken. Pour into the soup pot. Slice the sausage, and put it back into the soup. Bring to a boil, and cook for another 10-15 minutes.

To serve, ladle into bowls and top with a dollop of sour cream.

You can leave the soup for a day or two after it's cooked; it will gain depth and flavor.
